The Korsun Pocket: The Encirclement and Breakout of a German Army in the East, 1944 by Niklas Zetterling

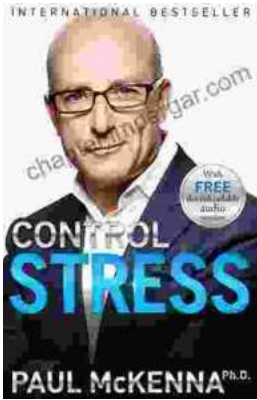
